Editorial #

Re-Defining Social Activism in the context of the 21st Century

- he beginning of the 21st century witnessed unparalleled developments in the field of technology and digital communications. With the advent of the Internet, human society has undergone considerable changes and each of these changes has impacted human life in every way possible. Today, technology and social change are intimately linked to one another. This has provided a platform for activists to bring into the public view the ongoing issues of our society and to mobilize people into forming protest groups and alliances for tackling such problems. Social movements are no longer confined to only a particular locality or region; digital technologies are now used as tools for broadcasting concerned issues which immediately reach the wider public domain within the span of a few seconds. This has given rise to what we call today as 'Digital activism' or 'Internet activism'. This online wave of social activism has helped fuel an unprecedented wave of social justice movements all around the world. Among the various forms of digital activism are email and social media campaigning, virtual sit-ins, and "hacktivism".
- The role of Social Media has been instrumental in spreading mass awareness. It is a means to grassroot level mobilization and provides numerous ways to engage protestors and activists in a diverse range of causes. 'Hashtag' culture has allowed activists to assemble an online community of supporters from around the world, who in turn help the cause by signing online petitions, raising funds and sharing valued information and opinions on the Internet. The #MeToo movement which first gained momentum in 2017 aims at empowering women to speak out about their experiences of sexual abuse and harassment. The movement found its way into the global domain when the hashtag #MeToo went viral on social media platforms with over a million tweets within the span of two days. On Facebook, about 4.7 million users shared 12 million posts in less than 24 hours. The response to this digital movement was widespread media coverage and discussion on sexual harassment issues, particularly in Hollywood.
- Similarly, the "Black Lives Matter" movement is one of the largest of its kind in American history. The movement largely owes its widespread significance to the technology used to facilitate its public outreach and organization. In May of 2020, a video footage capturing the murder of George Floyd by four Minneapolis police officers started circulating on social media platforms and soon created international mass awareness. On the 28th of May, three days after the murder, the hashtag #BlackLivesMatter had over 8.8 million tweets. The struggle in the public sphere was greatly fueled from the virtual one. Starting from online petitions to protest-guides, the BLM movement found its engine among the online community of supporters. This major mass upheaval resulted in cities in the US cutting billions of dollars from police funds, introduction of several police-reform bills and a resurgence of black history awareness in America.
- Although the Internet and other digital tools have been crucial in the spreading of mass awareness, it sometimes also serves as a peril for the same. This is due to the malevolent attempts of those who use the same platforms for spreading misinformation and hate speech. This has often endangered the progress of a movement. Also online based movements are often leaderless and lack cooperation and there is no mechanism for proper decision-making.
- With further advancements in technology and communication sciences, a world of possibilities lies ahead of us to incorporate its usage in propagating revolutionary ideas and beliefs and changing societal structures with the help of global mass mobilization. This world of interconnectivity helps in the promotion of inclusivity and the emancipation of marginalized groups in making their voices heard, thus bringing in crucial changes. Surely, there are exciting times ahead.

A total of 153 books were donated to the K.K.H. Central Library by various alumni of the college and reputed personalities across Assam in 2022.





the decent dame with beauty.


Now people call me- the venomous beauty.
